Sharon Clute teaching East Coast Swing/Jitterbug: Sharon has taught Ballroom Dancing for numerous years in the DFW area. Sharon has been dancing since early childhood, falling in love with the rehearsals, lessons, and especially the bling. Sharon serves on the board of Ballroom Dance Dallas. She adores Ballroom Dancing as well as performing with the Dallas Tap Dazzlers. Come early and learn a new step or two and brush up on the basics.

East Coast Swing/Jitterbug: The dance was created by dance studios including the Arthur Murray Dance Studios, and is based on the Lindy Hop. Lindy Hop was felt by dance studios to be both too difficult and too unstructured to teach to beginning dancers, but there was a marked demand for training in Swing Dance.

East Coast uses a six-step pattern with music employing 4 beats per measure, three measures of music are required to complete two sets of steps

In practice on the social dance floor, the six count steps of the East Coast Swing are often mixed with the eight count steps of Lindy Hop, Charleston, and less frequently, Balboa.
