Rhumba: The dancers of rumba usually embody a smooth and sensual demeanor. The toes should be at a slight diagonal to allow you to achieve Cuban motion hip movement. The music in rhumba is in an even 4/4 time. The basic rhythm is slow-quick-quick, with the first step taking 2 beats and the last two steps each taking one beat. It can also be taught quick-quick-slow. The slow is always drug out. Rhumba is also taught as a box step and borrows some of our favorite steps from salsa such as cross-body leads and shoulder checks.

The arms are held in a traditional frame position to connect the two dancers in rhumba. However, the leader's left arm is held at a 90-degree angle to the floor. This creates a tighter frame between the dancers.


